Validation Scope: The Rainforest Alliance has validated that Prakash Industries Ltd. is in compliance with *Climate, Community and Biodiversity Project Design Standards, First Edition, May 2005* at the Gold Level of approval. This independent third-party validation covers the carbon project design for the reforestation of degraded lands in Chhattisgrah, India using the tree species *Gmelina arborea* and *Albizia lebbek*. The project began in 2002 and will have a duration of 20 years. The total area of the project is 282 hectares of privately-owned tree plantation sites located in Rano, Rano II, Pendravan, Saleh and Lara, in the districts of Durg, Rajnandgaon and Raigrah of Chhattisgrah state.
