The Rainforest Alliance has validated that the **Forest Again** project design is in compliance with *The Climate, Community and Biodiversity Alliances Standards, Second Edition* and attained the gold level of approval for exceptional community and adaptation benefits. This independent third-party validation covers the project on an area of 490 hectares of public land located in the Kakamega Forest Reserve in the Western Province of Kenya. The Forest Again reforestation project was developed on behalf of the Kenyan Forest Service to restore indigenous forest on cleared open forest and grassland. The aim of the project is to restore and conserve biodiversity, enhance local livelihoods, and to sequester approximately 422,000 of CO₂ during the 40 year project length.
